Meeting opened with bank account details with Billy explaining to everyone the with holding tax how high it is for our account and asked bill if he would go to Kiwi Bank to see if we could another account for us with a lower tax rate, Bill will do this for the club this week and will let members know how he got on at the next meeting, this was discussed and moved by Billy P and second by Clinton.

Apologies were read out by Bill and it was explained why some members couldn't attend this meeting.

Next up was the Swap meet this was to be held on the 24th of September but had to cancelled as we couldn't get the Tikipunga Tavern car park as it had been booked for that Saturday for a day of car drifting, so Bill will go and see if we can get the space for Saturday the 17th of September and hopefully we can get this date and have our swap meet. For the Swap meet Barbara done a great job of getting a price so that we can advertise in the advocate news paper but the price for that was a bit steep so we have decided to do the advertising our self's by putting up signs around Whangarei and Dargaville and any where we can to get people there, Worzel is going to print off the flyers for us on his private printer he has a government issue one they are had to find so that's our secret, thanks to Barbara and Worzel for the help.

Next up was screen prints for tee shirts Bill got a price of Trevor Moss in Dargaville for making a screen and for printing, for getting the screen made up @ a cost of \$65 to \$80 and for putting the emblem onto shirts is a cost of \$6 to \$7 per shirt + GST, the screen will be the clubs property once it is made, this was put to discussion and Billy said that Glen Mills the Auckland area co-ordinator could possibly be a screen printer so it was decided that Bill ask Glen and if he is to get a price of him to do the same thing, Bill has

Emailed Glen and he is just waiting for a reply. The emblem to be screen printed is the Triumph badge with NORTHLAND printed on the top all print will be white on black tee shirts and the outline of the triangle will be white as well, this will be on the left side at pocket height and should look quite smart

Next up was the club badges that read NORTHLAND T.O.M.C.C these are made at stitches in Whangarei where Mozy had some made up a few years back these can be made again at a cost of \$7 + GST per badge and these will be sold to members at a cost of \$10 each, it was decided at this stage to get ten printed up so Bill will arrange this to be done, this was moved by Billy P and second by Worzel.

The club has acquired a Harley Davidson Pool Queue in a case and this has gone for a raffle to get more funds for our Waiheke trip the tickets are selling well @ \$2 per ticket and there are 50 tickets so if those who haven't got a ticket and would like one head out the Hukerenui Pub as Bob is selling the rest of them over the bar for us. The Waiheke trip will be in April 2012 about the 1st weekend and we will be going rain or shine, the club will pay for paid up members return on the ferry and will send a koha over to Steve and Jay so that they can get some food for the trip you will have to take your tent and buy your drinks over there, sending money over to Steve will save us carting it all over there so kept the 1st weekend in April free for this road trip.

Burns run is on the 25th of September 2011 more information on this will follow later Worzel will let us know what and the where on this ride, the Treble T Sam will let us know about a date on this later it is usually the 1st weekend in November but Sam will find out for us, thanks Sam.

The Poker run for next March is still under discussion so an input into this is valid so Billy, Rennie and Bill can start looking into it, some routes have been discussed and ideas put forward so far we have Billy and Jenny's place but there is not a lot of room to be able to cater for a lot of people so we have to take into consideration Billy and Jenny's thoughts and ideas as to having the after ride there, the other place we had in mind was Rennie's place up at Donnelly's Crossing as we didn't get to ask him if it was okay we still have to ask him, but there could be hitch there as well but well worth looking at, a lot depends on some thing Rennie is working on at the moment, so please some thoughts on where to have this function after the ride all input will be given great consideration.
